Glendale renews contract with Hamilton Co. Development Co.

The Village of Glendale has renewed its contract with the Hamilton County Development Co. for economic development services.

HCDC, a not-for-profit economic development agency, will work closely with the Glendale Chamber of Commerce to expand the promotion and marketing of Glendale businesses.

This will be the second year HCDC has collaborated with Glendale to assist businesses in the Village. In the first year of the contract, HCDC, the Glendale Chamber and local businesses set priorities for continued development of small businesses in the neighborhood. Representatives of HCDC met with 35 local businesses and identified improvements to the main business district, the Village Square, as a top priority.

HCDC also organized several small-business assistance sessions for businesses, bringing in experts on search engine optimization, social media, and web site design. A small-business open house featuring assistance providers such as business coaches and small-business financing programs is also planned.

“HCDC has done an outstanding job over the past year helping the Village and Chamber of Commerce focus on making the business districts more successful,” said Glendale Mayor Joe Hubbard. “I would recommend HCDC to any city or village.”
